

Simulation Instructor Course

This course was designed to build on current training programs already in place. During this course, instructors will learn about Simunitions (FX Marking Cartridges), adult learning principals, safety equipment, safety protocols, use of force, development of realistic scenarios, demonstrated performance objectives, training liability and handling difficult students. This course is a dynamic use of force based training model, not a firearms course. Instructors from corrections, parole and probation and police are encouraged to attend this training.

Participants who wish to attend this course should meet the following minimum requirements:

- Physically fit to attend training requiring physical force, long periods of movement, exposure to heat, and the ability to move up and down off the ground unassisted.
- Has at least two years experience as a correction, parole, probation or police officer.
- Has attended at least one of the following instructor development courses that required the officer to complete a minimum of 40 hours of instructor development training.
 1. Firearms
 2. Defensive Tactics
 3. Ground Fighting
 4. Chemical Agents
 5. Baton
 6. Use of Force

Equipment Required:

- Full duty gear and/or gear worn on duty.
- Ballistic vest if applicable.
- Safety Glasses
- Long sleeve shirt
- Long pants
- Towel
- Water bottle
- Handcuff key
- Flashlight
- Handcuffs
